1. 2021 Season Review – 1st XI

Overview

- After a long hard fought season, we had a very strong finish to the season finishing 6th of 10 teams (6 wins and 8 losses)
- A few tight losses, namely on the opening day of the season at Findon, meant it was more nerve racking than it should have been

Highlights

- Steve Calder Smith top scored with 342 (491 runs including 2nd XI runs) runs at an average of 27 (33 if including 2nd XI)
- James Rainford got the most wickets with 15 wickets at an average of 26
- Emergence of Nick Klein the destructive No. 6 averaging 58 with the bat!
- Another strong year from "the wall" Jonny Farmer (279 at an average of 31)
- o James Rainford stepping up into vice captain role and proving his leadership capability
- Will Dixon breakthrough season into the 1st team more colts to be tried and tested next season we hope

1. 2021 Season Review – 2nd XI

Overview

- o Relegated by 1 point leaving us ruing the 2 point deduction for fielding unregistered players (lesson learned)
- 4 wins and 10 defeats with availability from 1st team squad really impacting ability to field strong 2nd XI

<u>Highlights</u>

- George Nicholls and Steve Calder Smith scored 149 runs over the season the former with an average of 21 the later close to 50!
- Other notable run scorers: Will Dixon (143 at an average of 29), Tom Dawson (132 at an average of 26) and Harry Hunter (120 at an average of 13)
- Special mention to Ken Vickery for his contribution of 119 runs still outscoring Frank (and very nearly Dan) at the age of 65
- o Other notable individual performances:
 - Rich Wilson 67 vs West Wittering
 - Tom Dawson 64 vs Chippingdales
 - Will Dixon 59 vs Crawley Eagles
 - Harry Hunter 47 vs Portslade
- Top wicket taker was Frank Vickery with 19 wickets at an average of 15 clearly a very big miss for the second half of the season when the 2nd XI struggled to bowl sides out
- Best individual performance was Frank Vickery with 5/28 against Crawley Eagles after taking off the wicket keeping gloves half way through the innings
- o Other notable wicket takers include:
 - o Josh Dixon (15 wickets at 26),
 - Oscar Warmington (9 wickets at 28)
 - Juan Vorster (8 wickets at 30)

<u>Lowlights</u>

- o Relegated on the last day of the season
- \circ Poor availability including last game when we were scrambling for players


