Captains to agree at toss (if no agreement 17" lines on both sides of wicket to be the guide).
Other Rules/Directives	In all matches in all divisions max 5 fielders on the leg side at any time. In LO matches all types of "No Ball" to be followed by a free hit (see L5.8). ECB Directives regarding Fast Bowling, Fielding Distances & Wearing of helmets by young players apply to all matches.
